Format & Procedures:

- By the submission deadline, performance recordings are uploaded as unlisted videos to YouTube and input into the registration platform.
- PDF sheet music is input into the registration platform.
- Groups receive a rating of Gold, Silver or Bronze. This rating system is aligned with rating system of MusicFest Canada. **Optional**: groups may elect to be adjudicated without a rating system. They receive a certificate of participation. Please indicate this preference when completing the online registration.
- A 30 min. clinic is scheduled between the Adjudicator and the Music Director to review the recording.

Repertoire:

- Three selections that fit within the 30 minute time limit.
- Selections can be changed up until the video submission deadline.

The rules and guidelines below are specific to the Mixed Ensemble Division. **Please ensure** you have thoroughly read all of the Vancouver Kiwanis Music Festivals General Rules.

Format and Procedures:

- By the submission deadline, performance recordings are uploaded as unlisted videos to YouTube and input into the registration platform.
- PDF sheet music is input into the registration platform.
- These classes are non-competitive classes. Adjudication is provided without marks.
- A 30 min. clinic is scheduled between the Adjudicator and the Music Director to review the recording.

Repertoire:

- Three selections that fit within the 15 minute time limit.
- Selections can be changed up until the video submission deadline.

Important:

- Complete only ONE registration per group.
- List the names of each instrument in brackets beside the performer's name in your ensemble when entering i.e. John Smith (violin).
- Once a piece has been performed it may not be performed again in another class.

NON-COMPETITIVE MIXED ENSEMBLE CLASSES

Three repertoire selections. Selections can be changed up until the video submission deadline. Time limits are to include all on/off stage movement and introductions.

MIXED ORCHESTRAL

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of recognized orchestral instruments, which may include one voice, with or without a pianist as part of the ensemble. Pianist must be within the average age of the ensemble.

MIXED CONCERT BAND

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of recognized concert band instruments, which may include one voice, with or without a pianist as part of the ensemble. Pianist must be within the average age of the ensemble.

Entry Fee Per Group: \$75

Time limit 15 minutes L4100A Elementary School L4100B Secondary School L4100C Community Group

MIXED JAZZ COMBO

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of recognized jazz combo instruments, which may include one voice, with or without a pianist as part of the ensemble. Pianist must be within the average age of the ensemble.

Entry Fee Per Group: \$75 Time limit 15 minutes

MIXED VOCAL JAZZ

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of voices with or without an instrumentalist as part of the ensemble. Instrumentalist must be within the average age of the ensemble.

MIXED CHORAL
