CONCERT BAND & ORCHESTRA RULES & GUIDELINES

The rules and guidelines below are specific to the Concert Band & Orchestra classes. **Please ensure you have thoroughly read all of the Vancouver Kiwanis Music Festivals General Rules.**

Format & Procedures:

- Each band or orchestra warms up for 30 minutes; performs for 20 minutes; then goes for a clinic with one of the adjudicators. Clinics are 30 minutes for each group.
- Groups receive a rating of Gold, Silver or Bronze. This rating system is aligned with rating system of MusicFest Canada. **Optional** groups may elect to be adjudicated without a rating system. They receive a certificate of participation. Please indicate this preference in the notes section when completing the online registration.
- Digital files of each group's performance are provided, along with verbal and written adjudications.

Repertoire:

Three selections that fit within the 20-minute time limit. (To include all on/off stage movement)

Vancouver Kiwanis Music Festivals is an affiliate festival of MusicFest Canada. Based on adjudicators recommendations, qualifying ensembles may be chosen to perform at MusicFest "Nationals".

CHORAL FESTIVAL RULES & GUIDELINES

The rules and guidelines below are specific to the Choral classes. **Please ensure you have thoroughly read all of the Vancouver Kiwanis Music Festivals General Rules.**

Procedures & Format

The Choral Festival format uses a unique pod system*. The pod system engages each choir in becoming both audience and performer, as up to three choirs are scheduled together. Each group will warm up for 15 minutes in their own warm up room; performs for 15 minutes back to back with the other choirs all together in the theatre; then will return to their warm-up room for a 30-minute workshop with one of the three adjudicators.

*Please note that depending on the Pandemic, we may change from the pod system to what we do with Band and Orchestra festivals.

- Groups receive a rating of Gold, Silver or Bronze. This rating system is aligned with rating system of MusicFest Canada. Optional groups may elect to be adjudicated without a rating system.
 They receive a certificate of participation. Please indicate this preference in the notes section when completing the online registration.
- Digital files of each group's performance are provided, along with verbal and written adjudications.

Repertoire:

- Three selections that fit within the 15 minute time limit. (To include all on/off stage movements)
- Any repertoire is permitted except Musical Theatre selections.

Please note: This festival is not appropriate for Show Choirs.

Performing Arts BC Affiliate:

They receive a certificate of participation. Please indicate this preference in the notes section when completing the online registration.
- Digital files of each group's performance are provided, along with verbal and written adjudications.

NON-COMPETITIVE MIXED ENSEMBLE CLASSES

MIXED CONCERT BAND

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of recognized concert band instruments, which may include one voice, with or without a pianist as part of the ensemble. Pianist must be within the average age of the ensemble.

MIXED JAZZ COMBO

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of recognized jazz combo instruments, which may include one voice, with or without a pianist as part of the ensemble. Pianist must be within the average age of the ensemble.

MIXED VOCAL JAZZ

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of voices with or without an instrumentalist as part of the ensemble. Instrumentalist must be within the average age of the ensemble.

MIXED CHORAL

Three to six performers consisting of any combination of voices with or without an instrumentalist as part of the ensemble. Instrumentalist must be within the average age of the ensemble.
